I am writing to share an announcement regarding an exciting career opportunity in academic medical physics. Specifically, we are seeking outstanding candidates for a tenure-track faculty position, at the level of Assistant Professor, in the Medical Physics Program within the Department of Physics at Louisiana State University.

The successful applicant will join five fulltime faculty and adjunct/emeritus faculty at LSU, seven adjunct medical physics faculty at the Mary Bird Perkins Cancer Center (MBPCC), and several physician faculty at MBPCC. We presently have CAMPEP-accredited MS and PhD programs with 24 students in total, as well as an undergraduate concentration in medical physics that prepares students for graduate study in medical physics or health physics. Our program partner, Mary Bird Perkins Cancer Center, has a CAMPEP-accredited residency program in oncology physics. Our faculty are funded by grants and contracts from state, federal, and industry sponsors.

To provide sustained program development, we are seeking an individual capable of both teaching (2 courses per year) and establishing a successful research program here at LSU. The applicant will ideally complement or supplement current research areas in diagnostic imaging (CT and MR), nuclear medicine, synchrotron-based imaging and therapy, image-guided therapy, proton therapy, microdosimetry, and biological effects of radiation.
